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## **Chapter 1: Read Me First**

This chapter provides safety information, handling and maintenance precautions and other important information about using the M900MGN Series rugged tablet.



## 1.1 Advisory Conventions

Four types of advisories are used throughout the user manual to provide helpful information or to alert you to the potential for hardware damage or personal injury. These are Notes, Important, Cautions, and Warnings. The following is an example of each type of advisory.

**Note:**

A note is used to emphasize helpful information

**Important:**

An important note indicates information that is important for you to know.



**Caution** A Caution alert indicates potential damage to hardware and explains how to avoid the potential problem.

## 1.2 Safety Information



### **Precaution on Battery Pack** **Précaution avec le bloc-pile**

Do Not Disassemble, Modify, or Insert Sharp Objects Into the Battery Pack. Electrolyte leakage, generation of heat, ignition or rupture may result.

## 1.3 Handling and Maintenance



### General Guideline *Guide Général*

Keep the product at least 13 cm (5 inches) away from electrical appliances that can generate a strong magnetic field such as TV, refrigerator, motor, or a large audio speaker.

Do not place heavy objects on top of the tablet computer as this may damage the display.

The screen surface can be easily scratched. Use with care. Do not use paper towels to clean the display but use the included cleaning cloth. Avoid touching it with a pen or pencil.

To maximize the life of the backlight in the display, allow backlight to automatically turn off as a result of power management. Avoid using a screen saver or other software that prevents the power management from working.

Use a soft cloth moistened with water or a non-alkaline detergent to wipe the exterior of the product.

Gently wipe the display with a soft, lint-free cloth. Do not use alcohol or detergent on the product.

### Touchscreen Guideline *Guide de l'écran tactile*

Use your finger or the stylus on the display. Using sharp or metallic object may cause scratches and damage the display, thereby causing errors.

Use a soft cloth to remove dirt on the display. The touchscreen surface has a special protective coating that prevents dirt from sticking to it. Not using a soft cloth may cause damage to the special protective coating on the touchscreen surface. To clean off hard to remove dirt, blow some steam on the particular area and gently wipe away using a soft cloth.

## 2.1 Introduction

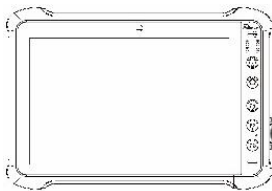

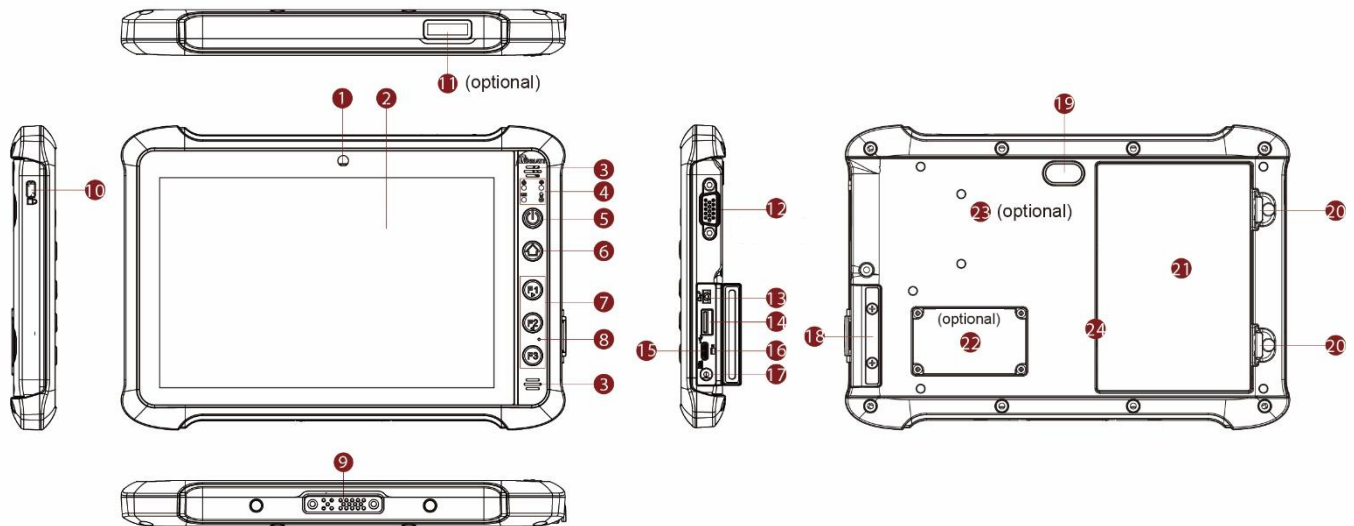

## 2.4 Hotkey for Specific Functions

For the physical buttons on the tablet computer, in addition to its dedicated functions detailed in the previous section, it can also be used to emulate commonly used keyboard key strokes. Under different scenario, a single physical button or a combination of physical buttons provide different keyboard key strokes, which are specified below:



Button	Keystroke
Menu	Home
Fn1	Volume Up (Note 1)
Fn2	Volume Down (Note 1)
Fn3	Barcode trigger (Note 2)
Power	Power ON/ OFF

**Note 1:** Fn1/ Fn2 can be used to increase/ decrease level when Brightness or Volume bar appears.

**Note 2:** Fn3 is trigger button when connected with barcode scanner.

## 2.5 LED Indicators Description

The LED indicators show the status of Power, Battery and are located on the front panel of the M900MGN Series Rugged Tablet.

Indicator	Icon	Description
Power Indicator		<b>Blue</b> – Tablet is on. <b>No light</b> – Tablet is off.
Battery Status Indicator		<b>Orange</b> – AC adapter is plugged in and the battery is charging. <b>Green</b> – AC adapter is plugged in and the battery is fully charged 90-100%. <b>Solid Red</b> – The remaining battery power is approximately 15-90%. <b>Blinking Red</b> – Charging in progress, the remaining battery power is less than 15%. <b>No light</b> – Battery is in use and the remaining battery power is more than 15%.

## Chapter 3: First-Time Operation

This chapter tells you step by step how to get the M900MGN Series Rugged Tablet up and running.





## 3.1 First-Time Operation

To get started:

- Install a SIM card (If your device is equipped with 4G/LTE).
- Install a storage card.
- Install the battery.
- Charge your tablet.
- Start the tablet.

## 3.2 Installing SIM Card (For 4G/LTE Equipped Devices)

The Tablet Computer supports 4G/LTE data connection and fits a Micro-SIM card.

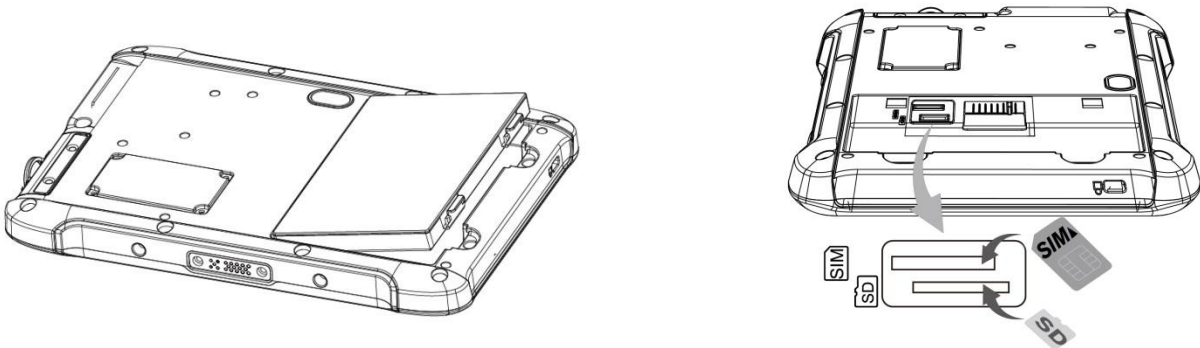


**Caution** Power off the tablet before installing the 4G/LTE module and Micro SIM card, or the tablet computer might be damaged by the incorrect installation behaviors.

*To install the SIM card:*

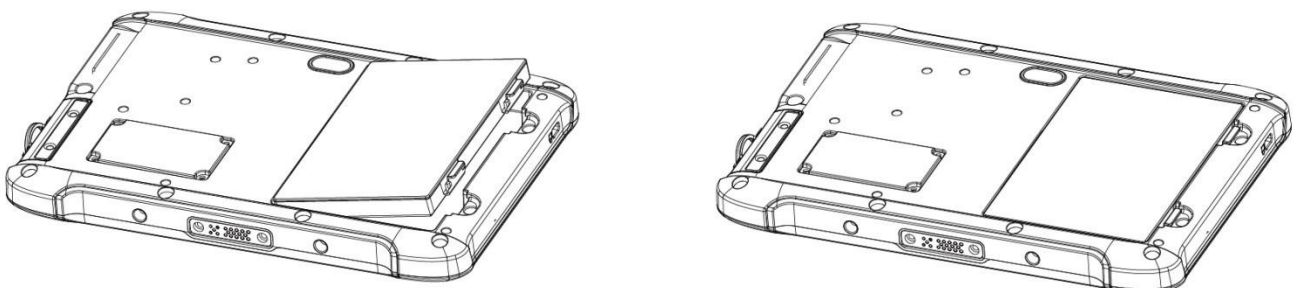
1. Remove the battery.
2. The SIM card slot is located right next the battery connector.
3. Install SIM card into slot with IC facing down the contact patch.



## 3.3 Installing Battery

*To install the battery pack:*

1. Disconnect any cords connected to the tablet computer.
2. Turn the tablet over, back facing up.
3. Insert the battery on the connector-pins side first, and then lower the battery into the battery compartment. Continue to hold the latches before battery is fully inserted.
4. Make sure the battery is completely lowered into the compartment before letting go the latches. Battery will be flat against the housing once fully inserted.



*To remove the battery pack:*

1. Shut down the tablet. Disconnect any cords connected to the computer.
2. Turn the tablet computer over, back facing up.
3. Hold the latches and lift the battery up to remove the battery.

## 3.4 Charging Your Tablet

The tablet operates either on external AC power or internal battery power. It is recommended to use AC power when you start up the Tablet for the first time.

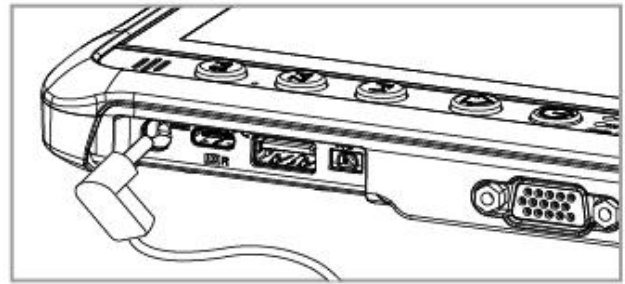
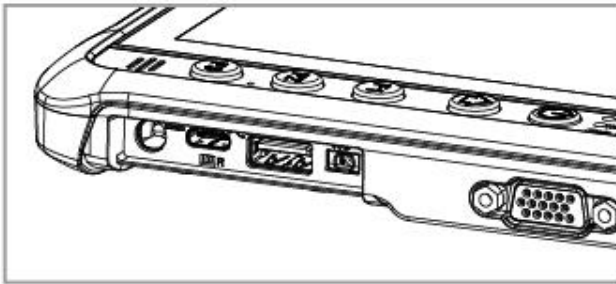


**Caution** Use only the AC adapter included with your Tablet Computer. Using other AC adapters may damage the Tablet Computer and the Battery.

*To connect a tablet to AC power:*

1. Open I/O protective cover by pulling out the latch.
2. Plug the DC cord of the AC adapter into the power jack of the tablet computer.
3. Plug the AC power cord into the AC adapter.
4. Plug the AC power cord into the electrical outlet.



*The battery LED indicator shows different battery states:*

**Orange** – AC adapter is plugged in and the battery is charging.

**Green** – AC adapter is plugged in and the battery is fully charged 90-100%.

**Solid Red** – The remaining battery power is approximately 15-90%.

**Blinking Red** – Charging in progress, the remaining battery power is less than 15%.

**No light** – Battery is in use and the remaining battery power is more than 15%.

Item	Battery Operation Time	Battery Charging Time
Standard Battery	10 Hours	2.5 Hours*

**Note:** Battery charging time is calculated when the battery is charging when the device is in shutdown state.

## 3.5 Starting the Tablet



**Important:** When powering on the device for the first time, please make sure there's no interruption during the Windows setting up process, for example, accidentally powering off. If it happened, please access the recovery menu by pressing **Fn1** button on the front bezel to initiate recovery process.

Press and hold the power button for **3 seconds** until the blue LED power indicator light up.



**Note:** Do not press the power button repeatedly.

Do not perform the following operations until the Disk Activity Indicator off

- Connecting or disconnecting the AC adapter
- Pressing the power button
- Touching the tablet buttons, screen, or external keyboard/mouse

*To power off the Tablet Computer:*

1. Make sure you have closed any programs that are open on the Desktop. Start Screen apps don't need to be closed.
2. Tap on the **Settings** charm.
3. Tap on **Power**.
4. Tap on **Shut Down**.
5. Wait for Tablet Computer to power off.



**Note:** The computer will forcibly be powered off if the power button is pressed and held for **6 seconds or longer**.








## Chapter 4: Using the Tablet

This chapter explains how to use the buttons, status icons, and controls of the M900MGN Series Rugged Tablet running on Android 13.0 operating system and provides instructions on entering and capturing data.




## 4.1 Using the Touch Screen

The touchscreen supports the core gestures for Android.

Gesture	Action	Description
Tap		To select or activate something.
Tap & Hold		Touch and hold an item on the screen by touching it and not lifting your finger until it responds.
Touch, Hold & Drag		Touch and hold an item for a moment and then without lifting your finger, move your finger on the screen until you reach the target position. i.e. moving the apps around the home screen.
Swipe or slide		Quickly move the finger across the surface of the screen. i.e. slide a lock screen to open the lock.
Double-tap		Tap quickly twice on a webpage, screen, or App to zoom.
Scale		Place two fingers on the screen and pinching them together.
Rotate		Two-finger press, simultaneously orbit both fingers around the center point, lift.

## 4.2 Waking Up the Tablet

If you do not use the tablet for a while, the screen dims and then darkens to conserve the Battery. To wake up the tablet:

1. Press the Power button on the top side of the tablet.
2. Drag the lock icon  upwards to unlock the screen.



## 4.3 Using the Home Screen

Home screen is the starting point to access all the features on your tablet Device. It displays application icons, widgets, shortcuts, and other features. User can personalize the home screen. See “Personalizing home screen”.



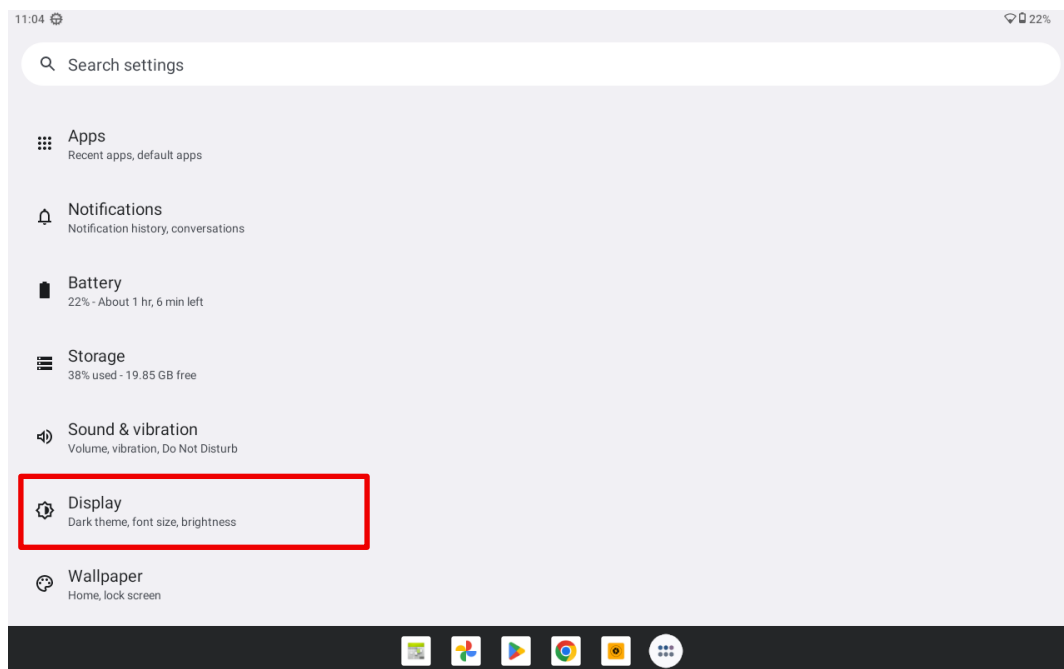
No.	Description
1	<b>Status Bar</b> – Shows the time, signal strength, battery status, and other notifications. It also displays notification icons.
2	<b>Application</b> – Shows applications that user can open directly on the home screen.
3	<b>Launcher</b> – Launcher icon to open the launcher and view all applications.

### 4.3.1 Personalizing Home Screen

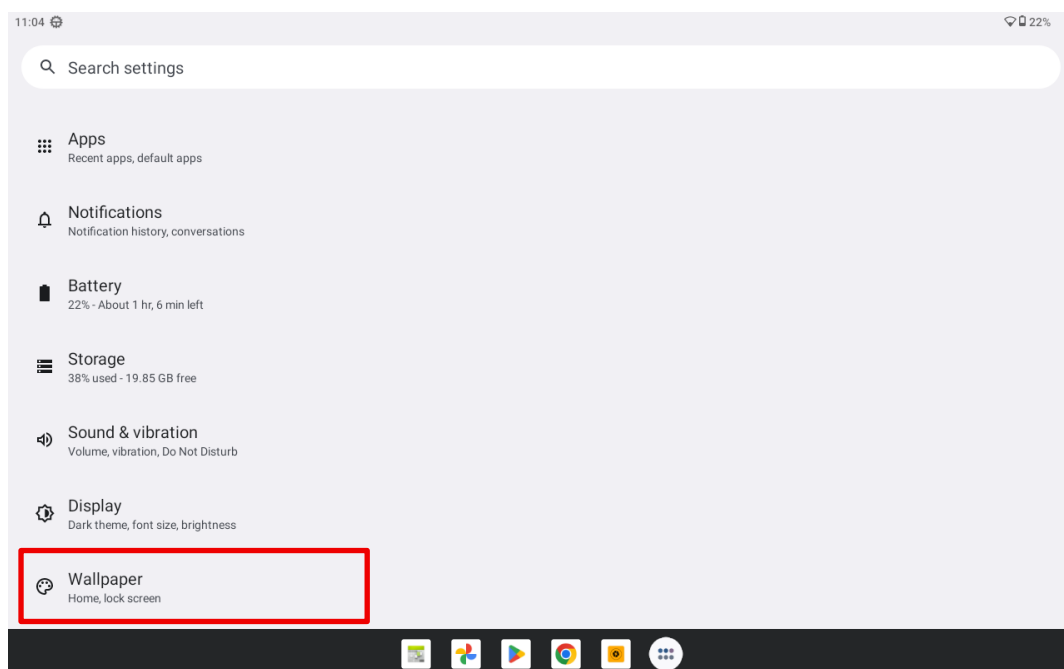
User can add application icons, shortcuts, widgets, and other items to any part of any Home screen where there is free space. User can also switch the wallpaper.

#### To change wallpaper on the HOME SCREEN:

1. Open **MENU** and then tap **Settings** ⚙️, and then tap **Display** 🕒.

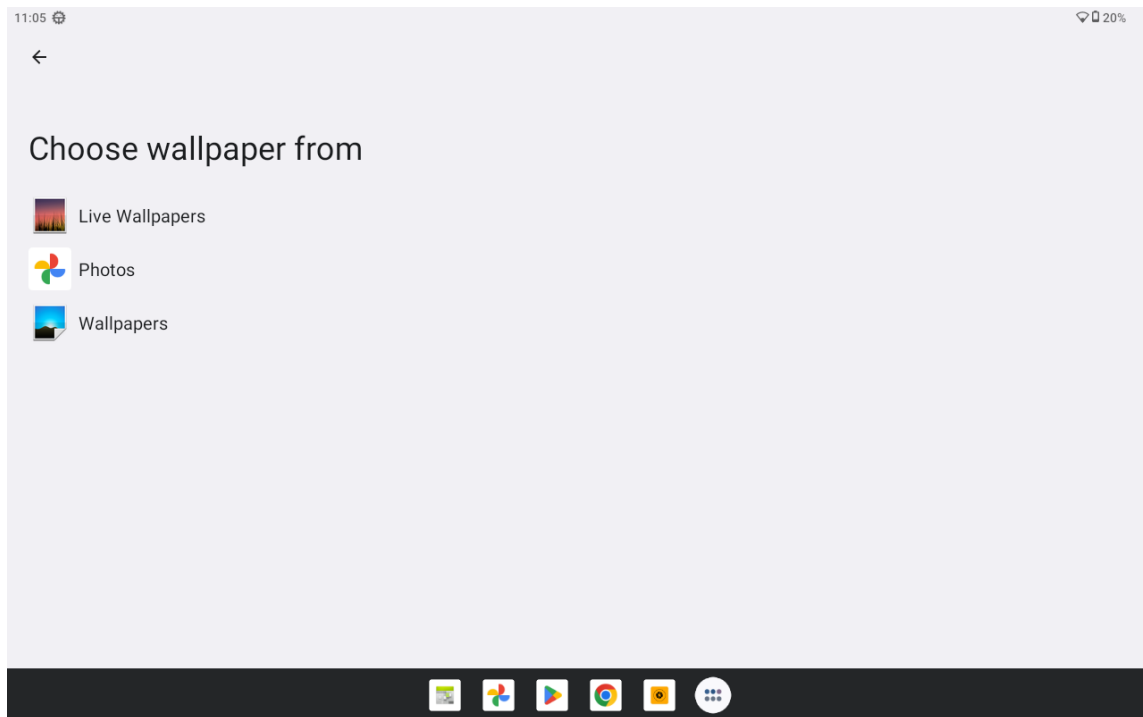


1. Tap **Wallpaper**.



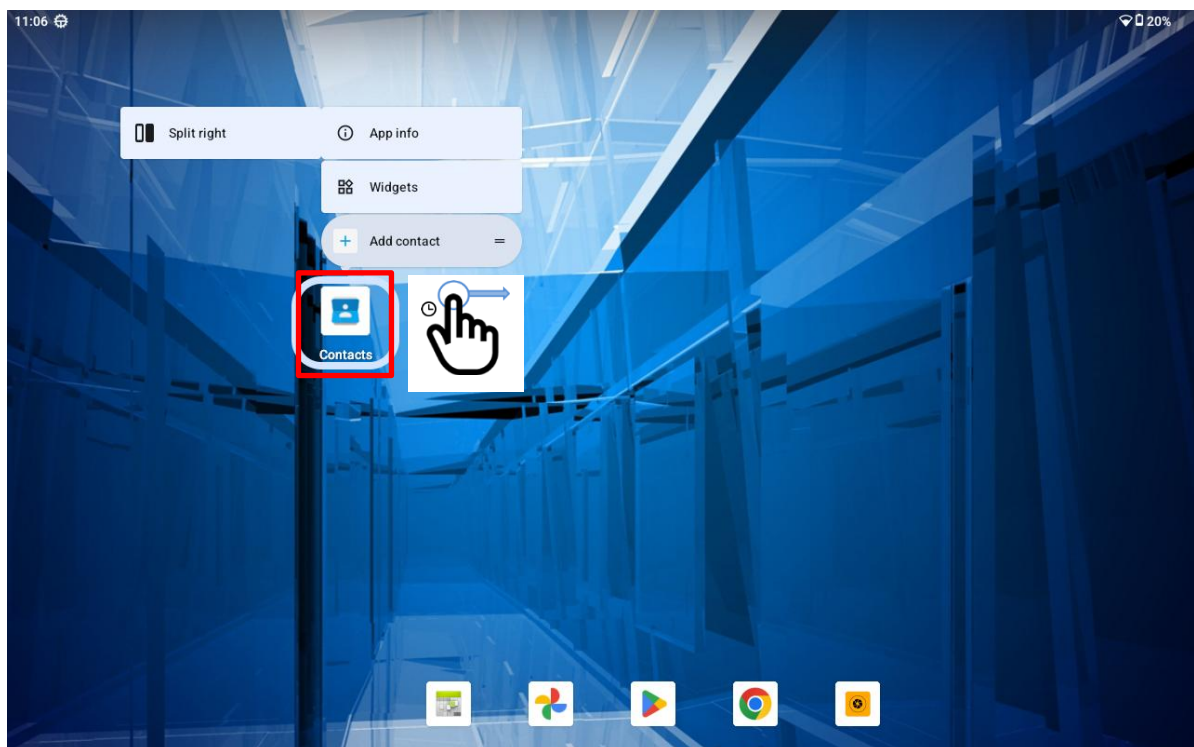


2. In the Wallpaper menu select the location of wallpaper, and then tap the type of item you want to add.

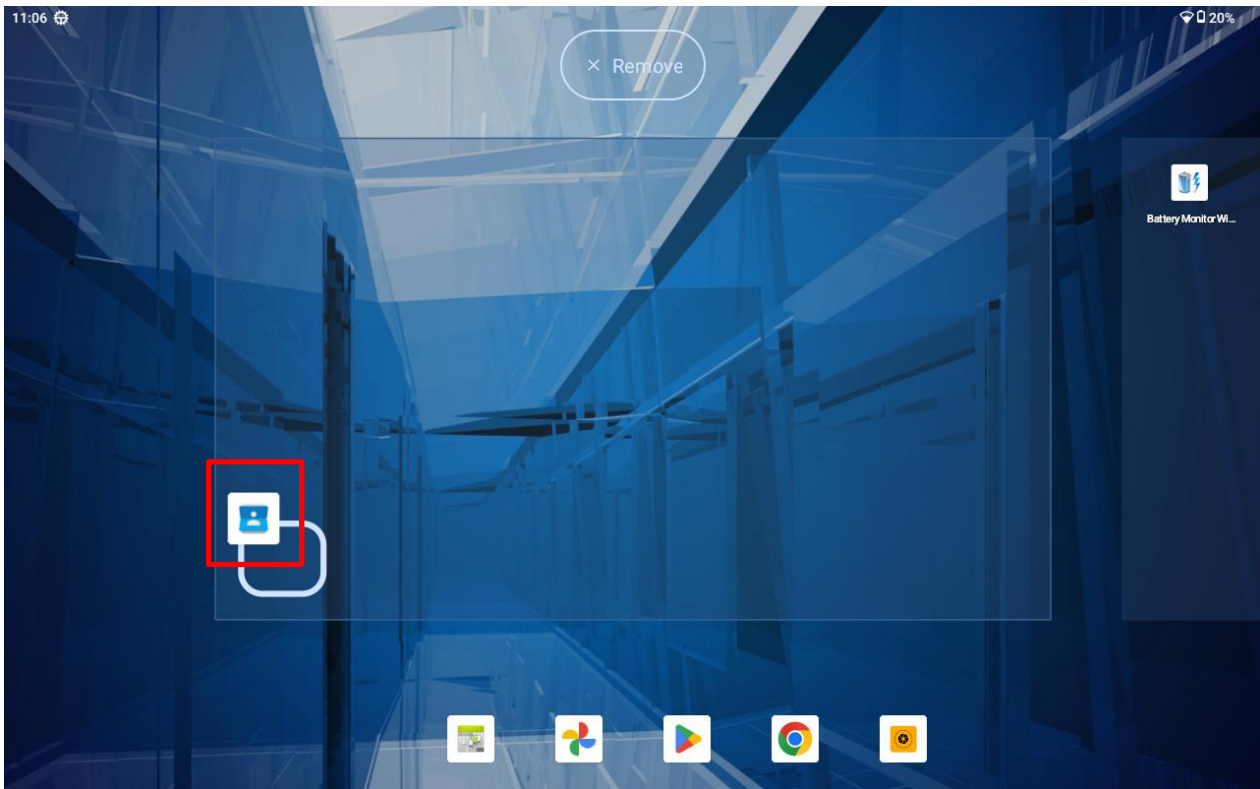


### To move an item on the HOME SCREEN:

1. Tap and hold the item you want to move, until it can be moved. Drag it to a new location on the screen.

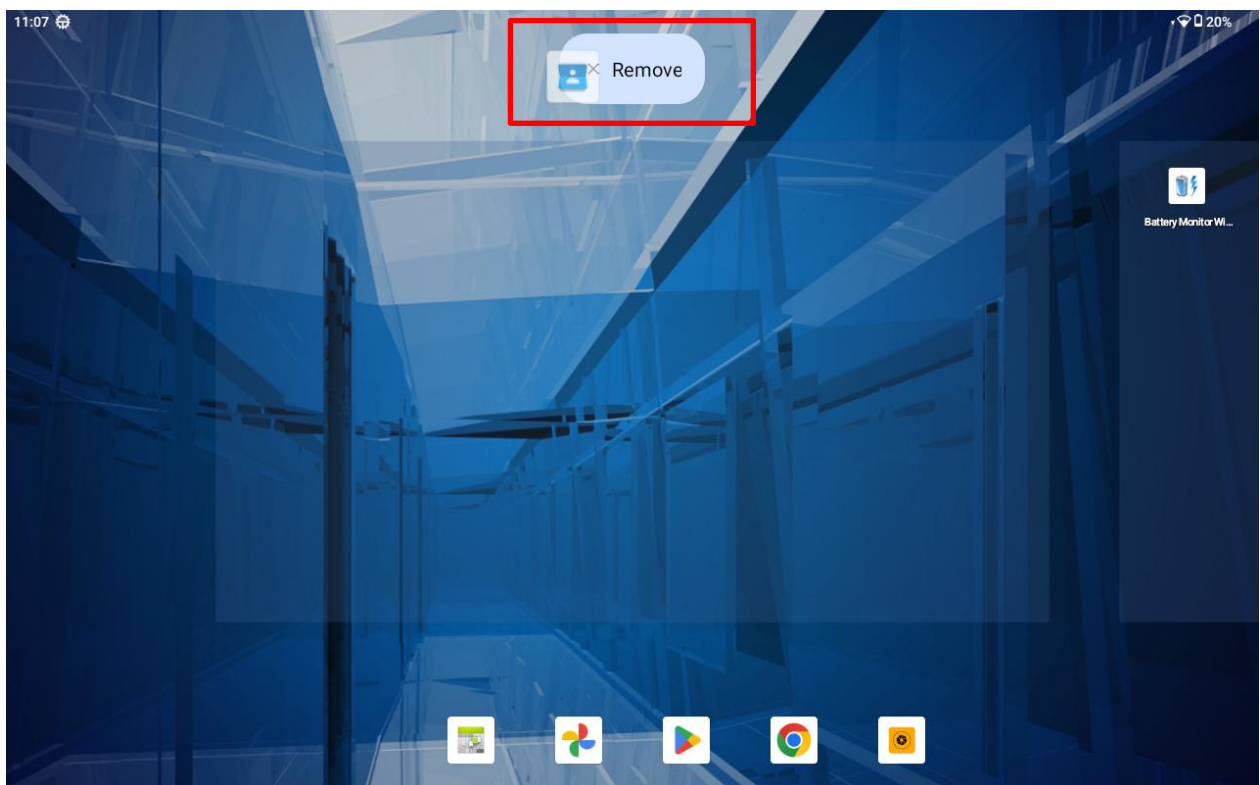


2. Place the item where you want to put it and lift your finger.



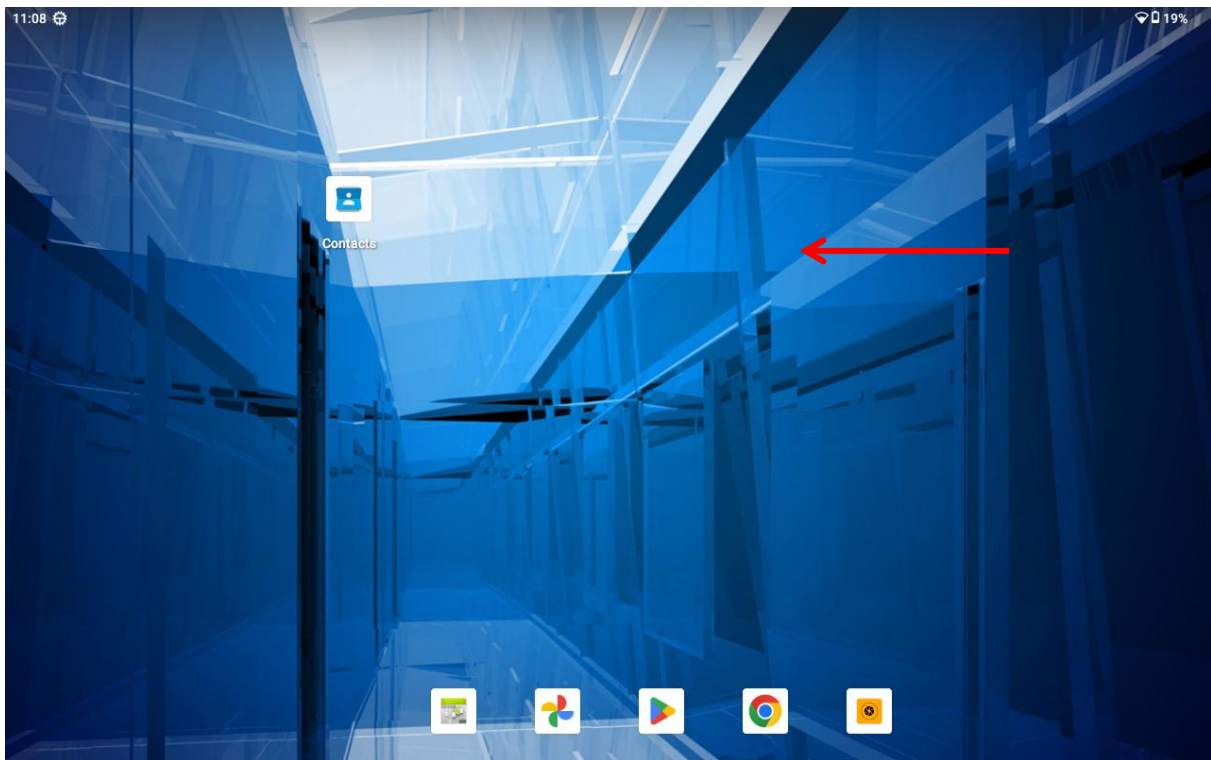
#### To remove items from the HOME SCREEN:

## Chapter 6: Networks and Wireless Devices

This chapter explains how to connect the rugged tablet to network and peripheral devices.



## 6.1 Connecting to Mobile Networks

When users install a SIM card from service provider to the M900MGN, the device is configured to use the provider's networks for voice calls and for transmitting data. Different locations may have different mobile networks available; user may need to configure the M900MGN to use certain networks.



**Note:** To obtain faster networks configure the device to 4G. To extend the life of battery user can use 2G network.

### 6.1.1 Checking the Network (GPRS/3G/4G) Connection

- Open **MENU** and then tap **Settings** ⚙️.
- Tap **More** in the **Wireless & networks**, and then tap **Mobile networks**.
- Tap **3G/4G Service** to check the network connection.



**Important:** Do not change the parameters of the access point to prevent inability to access network sources.

## 10.2 Basic Troubleshooting

<b>Barcode Scanner emits laser beam but does not read barcode presented to it.</b>	27. Adjust the distance between barcode scanner of the device and the barcode being scanned. 28. Make sure the barcode code type is enabled in the tablet. To enable/disable a specific barcode code type, go through the "Barcode Scanner Configuration" section.
<b>Battery leaking or swollen</b>	29. The lithium battery used in this tablet may swell after being charged/ discharged many times, but there is no problem regarding safety. 30. 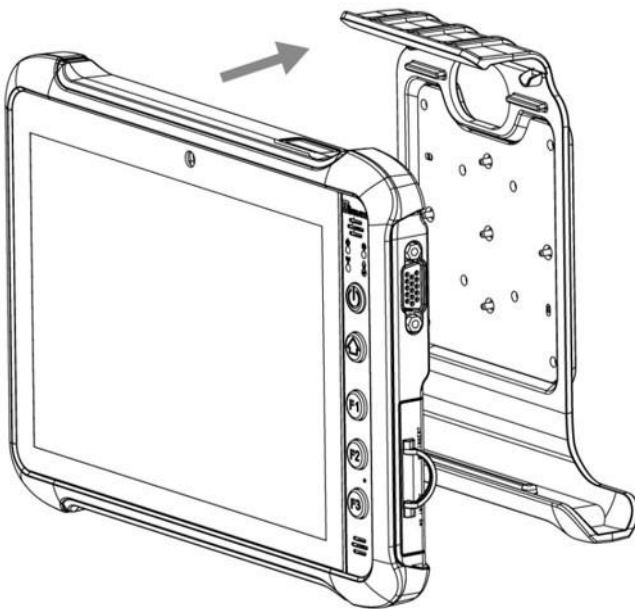

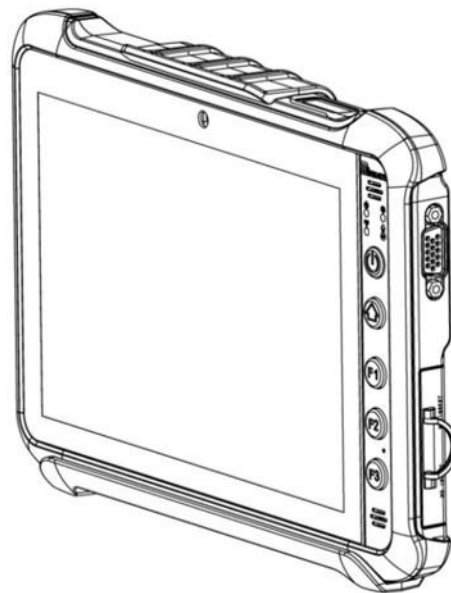

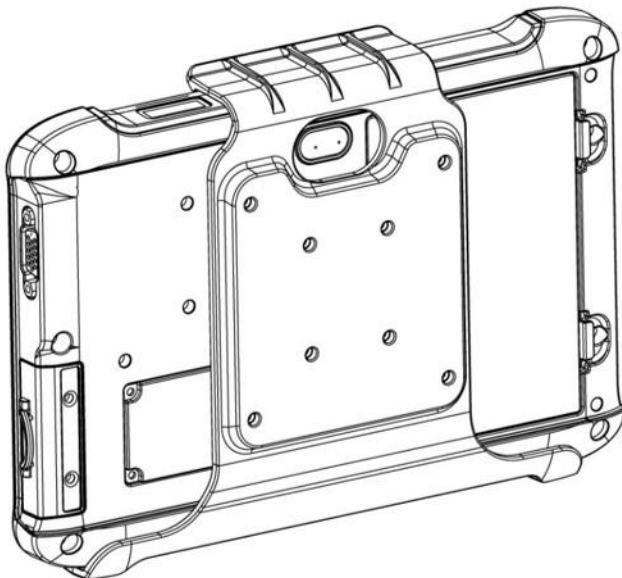
